SURVEY REPORTS

For the first part of IO2, each partner sent out a **survey to national SMEs** in order to identify the current context of green practices in their countries' small and medium enterprises. Results of the surveys were later gather in the **Report**.

The two main hindrances we repeatedly found throughout the Reports were SMEs decisionmakers' doubts on the economic return of green measures' investment, and the lack of generalized knowledge on green measures (be it knowledge on how to carry out green practices, knowledge related to employees' skills, or knowledge on public funding and policies).



Balance emerges as a commitment to the EU's century goal of becoming a climate-neutral continent. SMEs represent the backbone of the european economy, hence, through IO2 we aim to identify micro, small and medium enterprises' needs and concerns to aid them in their transition onto greener practices.

In order to do that, the last few months partners have devoted their time and effort to produce a **Report** collecting the general awareness and needs of SMEs in relation to green practices.
