OUR FIRST PRODUCT

During the first six months of the project, the partners devoted their time and effort to produce a Report - GREEN POLICIES & FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY. Each partner undertook national research in order to identify successfully implemented green practices in its country. One of the main objectives of the report is to show a diverse set of measures proven effective in the national business context and to increase environmental awareness. NATIONAL RESULTS

In order to understand better which practices benefit the most environment and how they have been introduced in the companies, the partners gathered into national reports information of 5 per country (30 in total) practices proven to work. Furthermore, the partners research the national initiatives for green innovation, entrepreneurship, awards, grants and other funding opportunities for green businesses.
